- Q2 Have you ever felt imposter syndrome?

- Q3 The CURTAIN in Jewish faith revolves around the temple where people would meet with God. It symbolizes systems that keep you out.
 Have you ever felt left out or ostracized by a system? Where or when was it?
- Q4 The STONE was a massive rectangular boulder and symbolizes the sin that keeps us away. Have you ever felt far from God because of sin in your life?
- Q5 The curtain was torn, and the stone was moved not to let God out, but to let you in.
 Sometimes our reality may have changed but our mindset hasn't.
 The only thing capable of keeping you from God is your own unwillingness to go to Him.
 Do you experience this in your life at times? Why do you think this is?
 Do you recognize it right away, or does it take a while?
